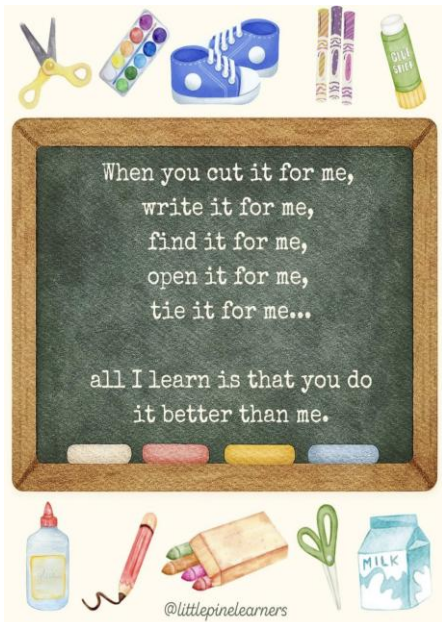
Daily News helps promote language, diction, grammar, waiting turns, and listening skills while building confidence speaking in a large group.

Journals are very important as we graduate from tracing to writing letters in our names. One thing that is unique and familiar to each child is their name. They may start by writing illegible letter forms but with practice they soon progress to writing letters and we can see this improvement as we compare the start and end of the month's entries. Their names are all over the room and they quickly recognize them and those of their classmates – exposing them to different letters.

Math is incorporated into all activities including the infamous 'lining up'. Here we can count our friends in English or Spanish, incorporate classification, sort by gender, hair color, clothes and directional e.g. This is also an opportunity to introduce serialization by height, age, and position to name a few.

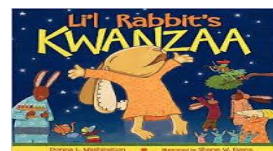
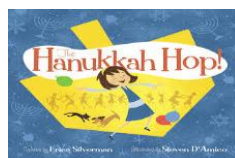
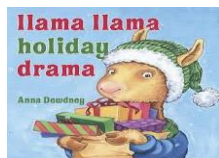
