We have completed our mid-year assessments, and we will be modifying the lesson plans and small groups to develop those areas that need more attention unique to each child. The children progress at various degrees and have different strengths and weaknesses, for example some children have very strong fine motor skills, but they need support in letter or number recognition. The main objective of these assessments is to check that there is some improvement in comparison to October's assessments.

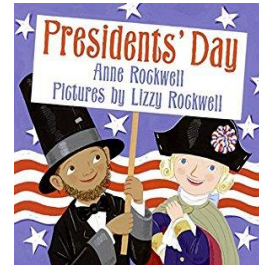
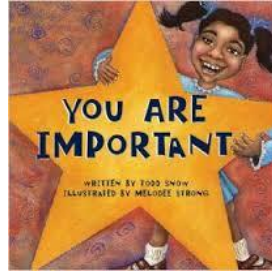
Tips for teaching letters

- Surprise your child with a note in their lunch box. - They love to 'read' it to us.
- Make a letter/ picture book with the letters in their name - each page a different letter.
- Make letters with straight pretzels, pipe cleaners, Lego, sand, tomato ketchup, play dough etc
- Have your child identify letters in cereal boxes, road signs, magazines, store names etc
- Write a letter, say its sound, and brainstorm words and find objects that begin with that letter.
